

ENGL152 Checklist (Spring 2018)

- Course must cover all three literary genres: short story, poetry, and drama.
- Model and encourage active reading through evaluation and interpretation of literary texts.
- Text-based argumentative and analytical essays totaling 3,500 words minimum, with at least one essay utilizing secondary sources
- Students must use the college's databases for secondary sources, in addition to textbooks and print sources, in their essays.
- Most recent MLA documentation (8th edition) must be incorporated in all formal writing assignments.
- Weighting of assignments: 70-80% of final grade should be based on formal writing.
- Students must be taught how to read, evaluate, and incorporate critical sources, including peer-reviewed academic journal articles.
- Bibliographic information session with librarians highly recommended. (Please contact James Marshall to arrange an information literacy session for your class. Do remember to provide specific assignment instructions in your request.)
