SEMINAR DESCRIPTION

Spend an overnight in the Monteverde Cloud Forest and walk above the clouds on the Monteverde Cloud Forest Sky Walk Tour. Wrap up the best of Costa Rica with two days in Guanacaste exploring the wealth and variety of Costa Rican culture.

- Transfer to the Monteverde Cloud Forest, nestled high in the Tilaran Mountain Range. This 26,000 acre private reserve is home to myriad of plants, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and over 400 species of birds. Dinner and overnight in Monteverde Cloud Forest.
- Morning Sky Walk Tour combines trails and suspension bridges above the canopy of Monteverde Cloud Forest for breathtaking views. Leisure time before dinner and overnight in Monteverde Cloud Forest.
- 2 Full Days in Guanacaste known for its fantastic beaches, but also features volcanoes, cloud forests, jungles, rivers, and waterfalls.
